### HOLY COMMUNION

Just a quick reminder that the practice of intinction (dipping the wafer into the wine) at communion is not recommended and highly discouraged. It is a potential source of the spread of infection and also an issue for those who are sensitive to gluten (for example celiac sufferers) since the gluten rapidly enters the wine. If you are not comfortable with sharing a chalice, please simply take a wafer and let the wine pass by.
